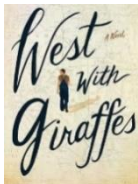

On Sunday, June 1, the City of Tustin will be closing several streets in Old Town due to the 41st Annual Tustin Street Fair and Chili Cook-off. The following closures will be effective from Sunday, June 1, from 4:00 a.m. to 10:00 p.m.:

- El Camino Real from Sixth Street to First Street
- C Street from Main Street to First Street
- Main Street from B Street to Prospect
- Third Street from C Street to Prospect
- Second Street from C Street to Prospect.

Sunday, June 1, from 6:00 a.m. to 8:00 p.m.:

- B street from Second Street to First Street.

The parking lots behind the church and the school district will be available for parking to worshippers, with access from B Street only.

### **SUPPORT OUTREACH TO CHILDREN AND YOUTH WITH THE PENTECOST OFFERING**



The Pentecost Offering is the newest and probably the least well known of the four special offerings of the PC(USA). As its name implies, it is received on Pentecost Sunday.

The Pentecost Offering was instituted specifically to benefit children, youth, and young adults. The offering is used to support several programs. Twenty-five percent supports Young Adult Volunteers (YAV). The YAV program provides young adults with the opportunity to serve alongside communities worldwide while sharing the Word of God. Young Adult Volunteers serve for one year. It is a transformational experience, and more than one third of Young Adult Volunteers discover that their call is ordination and pastoral leadership.

Another twenty-five percent supports Ministries with Youth. This ministry celebrates youth as the keepers of God's world capable of serving as leaders and as agents of healing. It sponsors Youth Triennium and other programs directed for youth. Ten percent goes to the Presbyterian Mission Agency to support its programs that advocate for children at risk around the world, seeking quality education to nurture mind, body, and spirit. The remaining forty percent is retained for our use in Tustin for local programs and ministries. You will find Pentecost Offering envelopes in the pew racks for your use.
