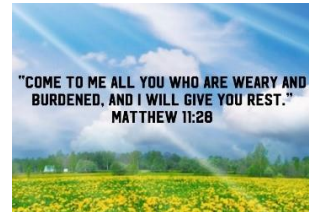
### FREE FLU SHOT CLINIC



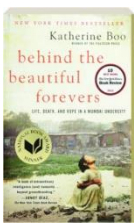
